	<p>KIK- Messaging App That Allows Users to Join Groups or Direct Message Other Users. Photos/Videos Can Be Sent, and All Can Be Deleted by Deleting the Application.</p>
	<p>WhatsApp- A Messaging Service That Lets Users Exchange Unlimited Text, Audio, Phone Calls, Photo and Video Messages. Messages Are Encrypted</p>
	<p>Telegram- A cloud-based instant messaging and voice over IP service. Telegram client apps are available for Android, iOS, Windows Phone, Windows NT, macOS and Linux.[16] Users can send messages and exchange photos, videos, stickers, audio and files of any type. Messages can also be sent with client-to-client encryption in so-called secret chats. Unlike Telegram's cloud-based messages, messages sent within a secret chat can be accessed only on the device upon which the secret chat was initiated and the device upon which the secret chat was accepted; they cannot be accessed on other devices. Messages sent within secret chats can, in principle, be deleted at any time and can optionally self-destruct.</p>
	<p>Whisper - A proprietary iOS and Android mobile app available without charge. It is a form of anonymous social media, allowing users to post and share photo and video messages anonymously. You can respond to a message publicly or privately, choosing a public anonymous post or a private pseudonymous chat.</p>
	<p>Mospace - Site similar to other social networking sites. Features include mobile games, chat, instant messaging, eCards, and photos</p>
	<p>Houseparty - A social networking service that enables group video chatting through mobile and desktop apps. Users receive a notification when friends are online and available to group video chat. The app is intended for teens who are ready for social media but are not old enough and is available on iOS and Android mobile devices and macOS devices</p>
	<p>Tumblr- Post text, photos, quotes, links, music, and videos from your browser, phone, desktop, email or wherever you happen to be.” It is a cross between a social networking site (like Facebook and Twitter) and a blog. It is often described as ‘microblog’ as people usually post short snippets of text and quick snaps as opposed to longer diary style entries found in more traditional blogs.</p>

	<p>Snapchat- A multimedia messaging app used globally, and one of the principal features of Snapchat is that pictures and messages are usually only available for a short time before they become inaccessible to their recipients. Hidden Features.</p>
	<p>Snapchat "My Eyes Only"- Hidden photo/video vault with password and encryption.</p>
	<p>Instagram- A photo and video-sharing social networking service owned by Facebook, Inc. The app allows users to upload photos and videos to the service, which can be edited with various filters, and organized with tags and location information. An account's posts can be shared publicly or with pre-approved followers. Users can browse other users' content by tags and locations, and view trending content. Users can "like" photos, and follow other users to add their content to a feed. The service also added messaging features, the ability to include multiple images or videos in a single post, as well as "Stories"—similar to its main competitor Snapchat—which allows users to post photos and videos to a sequential feed, with each post accessible by others for 24 hours each.</p>
	<p>Ask.fm- A global social networking site where users create profiles and can send each other questions. Some have used the site for cyber bullying, and has been blamed for suicides.</p>
	<p>Voxer- Walkie-Talkie PTT app allows users to exchange short voice messages. Popular for hybrid style of texting and talking, and has been used for cyber bullying.</p>
	<p>Tinder- Dating or anonymous hook up locator by geographic location.</p>

		<p>Yubo (Formerly Yellow)- A social media app for teens who can create video live streams with up to 10 friends and make new friends with the same age. The app also offers a swiping feature to swipe on friends of similar age and messaging features</p>
		<p>BurnBook - An anonymous app for posting text, photos and audio rumor messages about others. The app groups messages by school and/or college campuses. It requires access to your location so it can find all schools nearby</p>
		<p>Blendr is an online dating application based on geosocial networking for Android, IOS and Facebook. It's designed to connect like-minded people within close proximity. It was created by Joel Simkhai and patterned after his previous app Grindr which is instead aimed at gay men. Blendr claims to be "powered by" Badoo but largely appears to be the same service.</p>
		<p>Bumble is a location-based social and dating application that facilitates communication between interested users. In heterosexual matches, only female users can make the first contact with matched male users, while in same-sex matches either person can send a message first</p>
		<p>Wishbone- A survey app asking teens to choose between two various things. users are able to write comments underneath cards or, in the case that two users follow one another, send other users a direct message using a facility which is very similar to a chat room.</p>
		<p>MeetMe- A popular online flirting, entertainment, and social networking app and website. MeetMe is aiming people towards an on-line hook-up (its sister app is Skout, which is a well-known teen and adult flirting app. As part of the app registration process, you are asked your purpose as "friends" or "dating" and it creates a user experience based on your selections with one of the registration questions asking</p>
		<p>Musical.ly- was a social media service on which platform users create and share short videos Through the app, users could create 15-second to 1 minute lip-syncing music videos and choose sound tracks to accompany them, use different speed options (time-lapse, fast, normal, slow motion, and epic) and add pre-set filters and effects. The app also allowed users to browse popular "musers", content, trending songs, sounds and hashtags, and uniquely interact with their fans. Now Tik Tok</p>

Users can create and upload videos, remix others' work, or browse content created by other users and by famous recording artists. to go live on TikTok you need to have at least 1,000 followers. Once you reached this number of followers you will see an option to go live to your a select few or everyone on the platform.</p>
	<p>Minecraft is a sandbox video game that allows players to build with a variety of different blocks in a 3D procedurally generated world. Other activities in the game include exploration, resource gathering, crafting, and combat. there are many public servers for Minecraft that allow players to talk to complete strangers through a chat.</p>
	<p>Fortnite is an online video game developed by Epic Games and released in 2017. The game's online nature could expose younger players to iffy language from random strangers in voice or on-screen text chat.</p>
	<p>Roblox- A game-creation website where users design and upload their own games, as well as play other games in a multiplayer environment. Also contains chat function.</p>
	<p>HOLLA – A free, live video streaming app that randomly matches people in video chats across the globe. Think prank calling and party lines for the virtual age</p>
	<p>Omegle- A free online chat website that allows users to socialize with others without the need to register. The service randomly pairs users in one-on-one chat sessions where they chat anonymously using the names "You" and "Stranger"</p>

	<p>LiveMe - A tool for broadcasting live-streaming videos and watching others' videos. Viewers can comment on videos and give gifts to broadcasters and broadcasters can respond to comments and engage their viewers. Users purchase coins through the app to gift to broadcasters</p>
	<p>Live.ly- A live stream video platform that works alongside the musical.ly app. It allows teens to broadcast their lives to the world as it happens, it also initiates group video chats with their friends to hang out virtually</p>
	<p>Periscope- A live video streaming app for Android and iOS that lets you share and experience live video streams direct from your smartphone or tablet.</p>
	<p>Vaulty- Photo/Video Hiding App for Android that offers photo and video editing capabilities within its secret folders along with the standard PIN-protection for multiple Vaults and a Mugshot feature that catches snoopers red-handed</p>
