## Legacy Building Update, November 2025

- The initial asbestos abatement has been completed, however, after the pews were removed from the chapel (the pews were donated to a church in Mexico), more asbestos was discovered in the mastic used to install the chapel tiles. The asbestos company is now back on campus to complete the removal of the asbestos.
- The rerouting of the plumbing to remove it from the demolition area has been completed.
- Currently in the process of rerouting electrical lines to remove them from the demolition area.
- Continuing to wait to receive the site permit, which will then allow the building permit to be released. The demo permit has already been received.
- Continuing progress with Oncor to have overhead lines on 9<sup>th</sup> street moved to underground.
- Continuing progress with communication companies to have lines and poles removed from the church side of Avenue D.
- Temporary interior walls will begin to be built starting in December. These walls will shut off access to the demolition area.
- Once the temporary walls are in place, (tentatively by December 8 or the middle of December), interior demolition will start for the purpose of separating the Suter Building from the building that is being demolished.
- December 4-6, the Suter Building will have utilities shut down in order to reconnect the utilities that had to be rerouted for demolition.

- Pray that we will continue to meet our church budget as well as we continue to minister in the name of Jesus.
