
Legacy Building Update, February 2026

- The outside walls between of the Suter building should be completed and weatherized by the end of this week.
- The demolition company has started working on breaking up the slab of the old Worship Center and hauling it off.
- The debris from the demolition should be removed by the end of February.
- We have received a conditional site permit, but a few items are still being requested by the city before the full site permit will be released.
- Oncor has removed the overhead lines on 9th street and will be putting those lines underground.
- All the communication companies with lines located on the north side of Avenue "D" have been contacted and many have removed their lines at this time.
- As a reminder, the construction fence has been installed and now all the area inside the fence and temporary walls (area to be demo'd) are considered a construction zone and hard hats are required as well as permission to enter must be obtained from Talley Riggins, our construction company.
- Bricks from the Worship Center are still being placed by the Welcome Wagon at the MAC. We request that you limit yourself to **1 brick per family at this time**.
- We have been notified the rebuilding of the organ "chest" has begun and the company is on schedule to have the work completed to re-install the organ at the appropriate time.
