
Legacy Building Update, August 2026

- The elevator “base” has been formed up and will be poured shortly.
- The worship center slab has been poured and the walls for the ramps leading into the terrace seating are being built.
- The concrete for part of the chapel and the parlor area is scheduled to be poured on Monday, August 24. A section of this area will not be poured to allow the crane to have space to be placed to begin setting up the steel beams for the building starting in September.
- Currently, 9th Street between the MAC and the new building is scheduled to be closed on August 31, to assemble the crane that will be used to erect the steel on the new building.
- The city council approved the abandonment of the alley right of way. Once certain deeds are located, the replatting of the area can be done.
- A church member will be providing the cornerstone for the new building, and we are currently in the design and proofing stage for the cornerstone.
