
Legacy Building Update, June 2026

- The dirt work has been completed, which means the soil has been dug up, repacked and inspected according to specifications.
- All of the piers required in the plans for the building have been drilled. There are a few left to be drilled under the canopy on 9th street, but the building piers have been drilled.
- The beams for the new structure are in the process of being poured. They are starting on the east side of the property where the worship center will be located.
- As the beams are installed underground utility work will begin as well.
- All the communication lines have been removed from Avenue D.
- The slab for the worship center is scheduled to be poured by mid-July.
- Building permit fees have been paid and the permit has been issued. The work on the alley abandonment and replatting continues to be worked on by civil engineers as well as the city. It must be completed before a Certificate of Occupancy can be issued.
- A church member will be providing the cornerstone for the new building, and we are currently in the design and proofing stage for the cornerstone.
- As a reminder, the construction fence has been installed and now all the area inside the fence and temporary walls (area to be demo'd) are considered a construction zone and hard hats are required as well as permission to enter must be obtained from Talley Riggins, our construction company
