
Legacy Building Update, May 2026

- The dirt work has been completed, which means the soil has been dug up, repacked and inspected according to specifications.
- Approximately 1/2 of the 93 piers required in the plans have been drilled. Those are scheduled to be completed by the end of May.
- Once all the piers have been drilled and poured, work will begin to install the beams.
- As the beams are installed underground, utility work will begin as well.
- All the communication lines should be removed from Avenue D by this week, 5/22.
- Relocated the RTU Duct on the 3rd floor and it has passed inspection, so the 2nd and 3rd floor rooms that were affected are in the process of being returned to their prior use.
- Building permit fees have been paid and the permit has been issued. The work on the alley abandonment and replatting continues to be worked on by civil engineers as well as the city. It must be completed before a Certificate of Occupancy can be issued.
- A church member will be providing the cornerstone for the new building, and we are currently in the design and proofing stage for the cornerstone.
- As a reminder, the construction fence has been installed and now all the area inside the fence and temporary walls (area to be demo'd) are considered a construction zone and hard hats are required as well as permission to enter must be obtained from Talley Riggins, our construction company.
