
Legacy Building Update, July 2026

- All of the piers required in the plans for the building have been drilled. There are a few left to be drilled under the canopy on 9th street, but the building piers have been drilled.
- The baptistry concrete has been poured.
- The elevator “base” has been formed up and will be poured shortly.
- The beams for the new structure are in the process of being poured. They are starting on the east side of the property where the worship center will be located.
- As the beams are installed, underground utility work will begin as well.
- The concrete for the platform is scheduled to be poured by the end of July.
- The slab for the worship center, barring weather delays, is scheduled to be poured by mid-August.
- Spectrum has completed their work and the pole at the corner of 9th Street and Avenue D, should be removed.
- The work on the alley abandonment and replatting continues to be worked on by civil engineers as well as the city. It must be completed before a Certificate of Occupancy can be issued.
- A church member will be providing the cornerstone for the new building, and we are currently in the design and proofing stage for the cornerstone.
