2 Kings 13:10-13 (NLT)

¹⁰ Jehoash son of Jehoahaz began to rule over Israel in the thirty-seventh year of King Joash's reign in Judah. He reigned in Samaria sixteen years. ¹¹ But he did what was evil in the LORD's sight. He refused to turn from the sins that Jeroboam son of Nebat had led Israel to commit. ¹² The rest of the events in Jehoash's reign and everything he did, including the extent of his power and his war with King Amaziah of Judah, are recorded in *The Book of the History of the Kings of Israel*.¹³ *When Jehoash died, he was buried in Samaria with the kings of Israel. Then his son Jeroboam II became the next king.*
