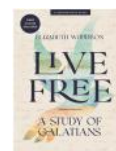


The Prodigal Ministry

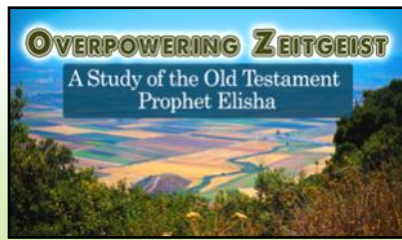
