Welcome Rick Dill

We are excited to welcome Rick Dill to preach today as part of the 25th anniversary celebration of our partnership with the Weimar (Germany) Church. After serving at *Wieuca* Road Baptist Church in Atlanta, Georgia, Rick and his wife, Nancy, joined the International Mission Board in 1981. The Dills worked with German churches and the European Baptist Convention in single adult and publication ministry. In 1990, after the Iron Curtain fell, they traveled to Weimar as church planters and started the Weimar Church. Rick was pastoring the Weimar Church when the Dills connected with FBC Garland in 1999. Then Senior Pastor, Steve Davis, and Associate Pastor/Missions, Jim Witt, took the first FBC Garland trip to Weimar the spring of 2000. That began our relationship, and 25 years later it remains strong. Hundreds of our members have taken mission trips to Weimar, and many from Weimar have traveled to Garland for ministry. The Dills came back to the US in 2008, and Rick became pastor of FBC Cleveland, Alabama, where he remained until he retired in 2022.


